

WHAT DO WE BELIEVE?

“... the faith which was once delivered unto the saints”

(Jud 1:3)

We believe in:

1. The Holy scriptures as the verbally inspired Word of God, inerrant, infallible and God-breathed.
2. In one triune God, existing in three persons - Father, Son and Holy Spirit; co-identical and co-equal.
3. That Jesus Christ is the Eternal Son of God, who became man, born of the Virgin Mary to redeem sinful men. He died on the cross, to accomplish this redemption, with the assurance of His literal, physical resurrection from the dead. Jesus, who is now exalted at the right hand of God, fulfills the ministry of representative intercessor and advocate.
4. That the Holy Spirit is a person, and is the supernatural agent in the regeneration and baptizim of all believers into the Body of Christ. Also, He guides believers into all truth.
5. That man is totally depraved and is unable to remedy his lost condition.
6. Salvation is the gift of God, by grace, and received by personal faith in Jesus.
7. That all who are saved have Eternal Security and Assurance of their Salvation.
8. That every saved person possesses two natures: old and new.
9. That all who are saved must separate from all religious apostasy, worldliness and sin.
10. That it is the obligation of the believer to witness of the truth.
11. The gifts of evangelist, pastor and teacher are sufficient for the perfecting of the saints today.
12. That the church is a spiritual organism made up of all who are born again, and that the local N.T. church practices are the ordinances of Water Baptism and the Lord's Supper.
13. In Dispensationalism, the personality of Satan, and the Second Advent of Christ.
14. In resurrection of all men: the saved unto eternal life, and the unsaved unto judgement.
